

## SEAMK ONLINE ENTRANCE EXAM 2021

### BACHELOR IN INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS

Student selection is based on the points awarded for the online entrance examination, which consists of two phases: written examination (parts 1A, 1B and 1C) and interview (part 2).

Applicants who pass the parts 1A, 1B and 1C will be invited to Part 2 (online interview). The applicant must reach min. 10 points in Part 1A, min. 5 points in Part 1B and min. 5 points in Part 1C to proceed to the online interview. Part 1A, 1B and 1C are done at one sitting. Part 2 (interview) about a week after.

**Applicants must reach the following requirements in each part of the examination to be admitted:**

#### PART 1- WRITTEN EXAMINATION

- Part 1A: Mathematical/logical thinking: 10 points out of the maximum of 20
- Part 1B: Essay: 5 points out of the maximum of 10 points
- Part 1C: Applicant makes a 2-minute-video according to instructions: 5 points out of the maximum of 10 points

The mathematical/logical skills are tested in a multiple-choice section. There is no pre-reading material for the examination.

#### PART 2- INTERVIEW

- Part 2: Interview: pass
- English language proficiency: pass

The applicant's English language proficiency is evaluated in connection with the entrance examination: written skills are tested in the essay and spoken skills in the video and the interview. The interview is graded on a fail/pass basis.

NB. Access to a computer with a webcam and internet connection are required for taking the examination. Please make sure, that you have the required equipment, and your internet connection is functioning. There is no pre-study material for the entrance examination.

## BACHELOR IN AUTOMATION ENGINEERING

Student selection is based on the points awarded for the online entrance examination, which consists of two phases: written examination (parts 1, 2A and 2B) and interview (part 3).

Applicants who pass the parts 1, 2A and 2B will be invited to Part 3 (online interview). The applicant must reach min. 7 points in Part 1, min. 3 points in Part 2A and min. 5 points in Part 2B to proceed to the online interview. Part 1, 2A and 2B are done at one sitting. Part 3 (interview) about a week after.

### **Applicants must reach the following requirements in each part of the examination to be admitted:**

- Part 1: Mathematics (min. 7, max 20 points)
  - a multiple-choice section testing mathematical skills
- Part 2 A: Logical thinking / mathematics and video made by the applicant (min. 3, max 10 points)
- Part 2 B: Applicant makes a 2-minute-video according to instructions (min. 5, max 10 points)
  - You have to make a video in part 2A and in part 2B by using your computer and camera (max. 2 minutes each video). It is recommended to use a function calculator, ruler, protractor, pen and paper in the entrance exam.
- Part 3: Interview: pass

English language proficiency: pass

The applicant's English language proficiency is evaluated in the videos (Part 2A and Part 2B) and the interview (Part 3). The interview is graded on a fail/pass -basis.

NB. Access to a computer with a webcam and internet connection are required for taking the examination. Please make sure, that you have the required equipment, and your internet connection is functioning. There is no pre-study material for the entrance examination.
