

METROPOLIA UAS: Proof of Identification

Autumn 2024 intake (Joint)

For programs that will use International UAS exam as selection method:

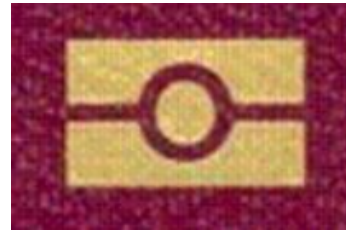
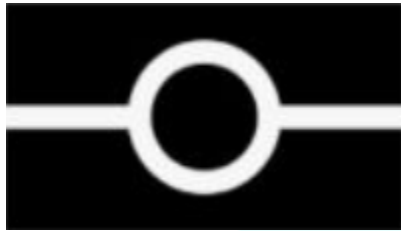
The applicant needs a valid, acceptable identification document to be able to participate in the International UAS Exam. The following documents are accepted as proof of identity:

- A biometric passport (ICAO 9303 standard compliant)
- A biometric EU/EEA identity card (ICAO 9303 standard compliant)

The passport/identity card has to comply with the ICAO 9303 standard. Other passports/identity cards are not accepted. All ICAO compliant documents carry the following logo. The logo is located outside of the front cover of the biometric passport or on the front or back cover of the biometric identity card.

Examples of the logo, the colour of which may vary between the identification documents of different countries:



The passport/identity card has to be valid until the specified date given by the university.

You have to submit the number of your biometric passport or EU/EEA identity card to the application form during the application period. In addition, you have to attach a copy of that document to your application form.

If the information you submit is incorrect or you do not submit this information to the application by the given time limit, you cannot identify yourself in the first phase written exam and thus not proceed in the International UAS Exam selection process.

Please note that your identity will be verified during the second phase group interview. The identification document that you show in the second phase must be the same document as the submitted document on the application form, otherwise you will be dismissed from the second phase.

Important note: A picture of the document will not be accepted, **you must show the actual identification document during the second phase in front of the camera.**
