

METROPOLIA UAS: Selection Method (Bachelor's)

Autumn 2024 intake (Joint)

Student selections in joint application for Metropolia University of Applied Sciences' bachelor's degree programmes are made based on the following:

1. International UAS Exam
 - Bachelor of Business Administration in European Business Administration
 - Bachelor of Business Administration in International Business and Logistics
 - Bachelor of Engineering in Automotive Electrics
 - Bachelor of Engineering in Construction Information Technology
 - Bachelor of Engineering in Electronics
 - Bachelor of Engineering in Information Technology
 - Bachelor of Engineering in Smart Automation
 - Bachelor of Laboratory Services in Laboratory Science
2. Pre-assignment + Online Interview
 - Bachelor of Arts and Design in XR Design

Important! The application instructions are subject to change until the beginning of the application period, and applicants are required to read the instructions again after the application period has started to make sure that they have all the latest information related to the application.

Please note! Applicants' eligibility is verified and certificates checked only for those selected as students and student selection is conditional until this has been done. Metropolia may withdraw the admission if an applicant is not eligible to apply, has given false information or does not deliver all the required documents by the deadline.

International UAS Exam

- International UAS Exam is a joint digital (online) entrance exam of Finnish Universities of Applied Sciences (UAS), used for selecting students to study programmes leading to a degree and conducted in English.
- The entrance examination assesses the applicants' abilities to study in universities of applied sciences. The entrance examination does not contain any pre-reading materials or pre-tasks.

NOTE: The instructions for the spring application will be updated on www.uasinfo.fi at the beginning of the application period. In the meantime, here are the **tentative** details of the entrance exam:

The entrance exam consists of two phases organized remotely online.

1st Phase: Written examination

The first phase of the entrance exam is a written exam conducted individually on the applicant's computer remotely online. You will receive an invitation to the written exam at the email address you provided in your Studyinfo application. This invitation includes a personal login link to the written exam.

To participate in the first phase written exam and progress in the International UAS Exam selection process, you must verify your identity. Before the first phase written exam, you are required to complete a pre-identification process within a specified time limit. An invitation to the pre-identification will be sent to the email address provided in your application form.

2nd Phase: Group interview

The most successful applicants of the first phase written exam per study programme are going to be invited to the second phase group interview. In order to be invited to the second phase group interview, the applicant must:

1. Pass the first phase written exam with a minimum score per section.
2. Meet the cut-off score for your selected study program.
3. Provide proof of English language skills in an acceptable document on the Studyinfo application form.
4. Submit an acceptable identification document on the Studyinfo application form

In the entrance examination, the applicants' readiness for UAS studies are assessed, therefore the entrance exam does not include any advance reading materials or pre-assignments.

Pre-assignment + Online Interview

- **Link to the pre-assignment will be published by the beginning of the application period.**
 - The pre-assignment must be prepared according to the instructions on the Metropolia website and uploaded to Studyinfo as an attachment to the online application by the end of the application period.
- Entrance examination is arranged online on **26 March, 2024.**
 - More detailed instructions will be sent by email to applicants invited to the interview.
- Only eligible applicants who have successfully completed the preliminary assignment and submitted an acceptable proof of English language skills as described above by the deadline will be invited to the entrance exam.
