

General information on the International UAS Exam

Autumn 2024 intake

The International UAS Exam is a joint digital entrance exam of the Finnish Universities of Applied Sciences (UAS), used for selecting students to study programmes leading to a bachelor's degree and conducted in English. The exam is completed by the applicant's own computer remotely online.

In the exam, the applicants' readiness for UAS studies is assessed. The exam does not include any advance reading materials or pre-assignments.

International UAS Exam is organised on 21 March 2024 from 12:00 o'clock noon onwards (Finnish time, UTC/GMT+2).

Identification

You have to identify yourself to be able to participate in the International UAS Exam and proceed in the International UAS Exam selection process.

The identification process consists of two phases:

1) Pre-identification (before the exam)

Before the exam, you have to conduct pre-identification in Candour ID mobile application within an indicated time limit. You will receive an invitation to pre-identification to the email address provided in this application form on **11 March 2024 at the latest**. Pre-identification has to be completed on **14 March 2024 at 15:00 Finnish time (UTC/GMT+2) at the latest**.

Another option to conduct pre-identification, within the time limit indicated above, is via the following link: <https://login.uasexam.fi/>. (The page will be activated when the pre-identification begins.) When logging in, please submit the same passport/identity card number and the PIN code as provided in this application form (passport/identity card number from the "Passport or biometric EU/EEA ID card (UAS)" section in the application form).

2) Identification on the exam day:

Those applicants who have successfully conducted pre-identification will be invited to the exam. On the exam day, you have to identify yourself again while logging in to the exam.

You need the following for identifying yourself:

- Passport or biometric EU/EEA identity card. The passport/identity card has to be valid until 21 March 2024.
- A mobile phone on which you can download the Candour ID mobile application

- Candour ID mobile application (available in App Store or Google Play). Make sure you have the latest version of the application installed.

PIN Code

You will need the PIN code in the later stages of the International UAS Exam. Please save the PIN code also to yourself. If necessary, you can doublecheck the PIN code also from your application after applying. You cannot change the PIN code after the application period ends.

Monitoring

Your activities during the exam are monitored in the exam system by SMOWL proctoring software. Monitoring ensures that the applicant completes the exam independently, without the help of anybody or anything else. The e-mail address in this application form

Please make sure that the email address you provided in this application is correct, it is in your own (the applicant's) personal use and you have access to it. Also make sure that you have free space in your inbox and check your spam and other folders regularly.

The invitation to pre-identification and to the exam will be sent to the email address you provided in this application. **If the applicant's email address is changed in the application form after 3 March 2024, the applicant will not receive important emails related to the International UAS Exam to the updated email address.**

Please note that incoming and outgoing emails from/to email addresses in Russian and Belarusian domains have been blocked in some universities of applied sciences. These include, but are not limited to, domains that end with .ru and .by. Do not use email addresses in the above-mentioned domains to ensure that you receive all the necessary information through email.

When logging in, please submit the same passport/identity card number and the PIN code as provided in your Studyinfo application. Please note that only those applicants who have successfully completed the pre-identification will be able to log in to the exam through the login page.
